However , you should provide specific citations (author names and publication years) to support these references . This adds credibility to your work and allows readers to explore related studies.
- 3. While you provide a good description of the research methods used, it would be helpful to provide more specific details about how you conducted your research, such as data collection techniques and how data was analyzed. This would give readers a better understanding of your study's process.
- 4. While you mention using both primary and secondary data sources , you could provide more information about how you collected primary data. For example, did you conduct interviews , surveys, or observations? Clarifying this aspect would enhance the transparency of your research process.
- 5. The recommendations are generally well-structured and provide thoughtful guidance for addressing the issues raised in your study. However, it could be beneficial to add specific details about how each recommendation can be implemented or elaborated upon.

For example , in Recommendation 5, you could mention specific steps or initiatives that could be taken to strengthen the healthcare system .
